RULES FOR PET OWNERS:

- ⇒ Pit Bulls are not permitted as per Provincial Rulings.
- ⇒ Existing Pit Bulls are to be muzzled in accordance to Provincial Rulings. No Exceptions.
- ⇒ Excessive noises or other disturbances from pets will not be tolerated.
- ⇒ Pets are not permitted outside unleashed or unsupervised or running at large.
- ⇒ No animal houses, cages, ropes or chains of any type are allowed on site.
- ⇒ Pets are not to be tied outdoors or left unattended on or around any area of the property.
- ⇒ Dogs or cats are not permitted to relieve themselves or be left unsupervised on balcony areas.
- ⇒ Stoop and scoop non-compliance will be referred to the City of Barrie By-Law Office.
- ⇒ Pets are permitted in the hallways of apartment buildings for entry and exit only, and must be on a leash or held. Aggressive dogs must be muzzled during entry and exit.
- ⇒ Dogs must have valid annual registration and rabies tags.
- ⇒ Cats must have valid annual registration tags per City Bi-Law effective January 1, 2007.
- ⇒ Pets are not permitted if they create an allergic reaction to other residents or staff.
- ⇒ You will be responsible for any and all damages caused by your pet indoors or outdoors.
- ⇒ No exotic pets or animals prohibited by the Humane Society or City By-Law will be permitted as a pet.
- ⇒ No more than (3) dogs or (3) cats are permitted per rental unit

The Residential Tenancies Act, states your rights and responsibilities with regard to pets. Specifically, you cannot be denied the right to own a pet, however an application may be made against you if your pet causes substantial interference with the rights of others, is of a breed that is inherently dangerous to the safety of the other residents or the landlord, or causes an allergic reaction to other residents.
